General Program Overview The Coordination of the Graduate Program in Health Sciences at the University of Taubaté (UNITAU) hereby announces the opening of applications and the selection process for the 2026 Caraguatatuba Class of the Academic Master's in Health Sciences. This program offers specialized academic training within two distinct concentration areas:

- **Clinical Dentistry**
- **Health Promotion, Prevention, and Treatment**

2. Program Characterization and Institutional Identity

Registration Period

March 9, 2026, to May 15, 2026

Submission Methods Applicants must complete both of the following mandatory procedures:

1. **Payment:** Remit the non-refundable registration fee of **R\$ 244.00** via the bank slip generated at the official application portal.
2. **Documentation:** Submit the required dossier by May 15, 2026, via email to posatende@unitau.br or via physical delivery to the Graduate Course Secretary at the Office of the Vice President for Research and Graduate Studies (Rua Visconde do Rio Branco, 210, Centro, Taubaté).
